

Criterion IV - Infrastructure and Learning Resources

4.1 Physical Facilities

4.1.1 The institution has adequate facilities for teaching – learning, viz., classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment, etc.

The institution has 3.95 acres land of its own in the heart of town of Rajgangpur in the district of Sundargarh. It was donated by late Pannalal Agrawal with the main building of the College in 1981. Subsequently, the College infrastructure have been developed with the grants/funds received from Govt. of Odisha, Govt. of India, UGC and MLA & MP LAD Fund. Now, the College needs more classrooms and laboratories as B Sc with honours in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany & Zoology have come up from the session 2017-18. The local MLA who is also the President of the Governing Body and the local MP have been requested to sanction Local Area Development (LAD) Fund to the College for construction and development of more infrastructure.

However, the College has sufficient teaching – learning facilities like class rooms, library, reading room, laboratories, Gymnasium, students common room, staff common room, SAMS laboratory, college office with computing equipments and a stage with a roof as per academic requirement. The College has 18 classrooms, 04 laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology and computers in the college office, Account section and SAMS Laboratory as everything is being done online. The College has also internet facilities.

A new building has been constructed with the grants received from Govt. of Odisha, UGC & with the College fund. Now, the main building of the College is being renovated as it was declared unsafe by the Dept. of R & B of Govt. of Odisha and it will be completed within two months.

Facilities for extra-curricular activities such as sports, outdoor & indoor games, NSS, NCC, YRC, cultural activities, public speaking, communication skills development, yoga, health and hygiene etc. are available in the college. The College has badminton court in the campus. However, the College doesn't have a play ground of its own. But, the College uses the play ground of the Rajgangpur Municipality & Rajgangpur Athletic Club.
