Waste Management steps including:

Solid Waste Management

S. D. Women's College, Rajgangpur conducts regular workshops, rallies and programmes on Swachh Bharat Mission by its NSS, YRC, NCC volunteers, cadets & the programme officers in charge. The College gives importance at utmost priority to Swachhta or cleanliness in the College campus. The volunteers also clean the College campus during special camps & programmes. However, the institution has regular employees to clean the College Campus and put the solid waste in the dust bin and the accumulated waste is being carried out by the Municipality at regular intervals.

Waste papers are also sold by making auction. However, the College uses papers which are written on one side and then only, these waste papers are sold by making auction.

Liquid Waste Management

The institution has a systematic & permanent drainage system to drain out all the liquid waste to the main drain line of the Municipality which is running adjacent to the College campus. Plumbers & workers are also engaged whenever; there is any blockage or damage in the drain.

E-waste Management

The E-waste Management is looked after by the computer section and it is cleared at regular intervals. The waste materials are sold by inviting parties for auction and completely damaged materials are sold as scrap.
